

Nebraska Ethanol Board Ambassador Application



All applications must be submitted by July 30, 2016.

Program

The Nebraska Ethanol Board Ambassador Program is available to all majors and grade levels at Lincoln-area colleges and universities. The program will take place during the 2016/2017 academic year. Ambassadors will earn a \$1,000 scholarship paid in two installments (\$500 on Dec. 1 and \$500 on May 1, 2017)

Ambassador Responsibilities

Ambassadors will be educated about ethanol production, technology, research, marketing and education during an orientation with Nebraska Ethanol Board staff. Ambassadors will:

- Participate in four promotional events throughout the year.
- Speak to four classrooms (middle or high school-aged students) and conduct a hands-on activity.
Ambassadors set up the school visits on their own with support from Nebraska Ethanol Board staff.
- Ambassadors are also encouraged to participate in industry tours, attend board meetings, job shadow an industry professional, or work on professional development skills with Nebraska Ethanol Board staff – resume reviews, interview practice, public speaking, etc.

With these opportunities, ambassadors will gain experience interacting with ethanol producers and consumers, as well as increase excitement and interest in ethanol. At the end of the academic year, ambassadors will reflect on their year and create a presentation to be given to the Nebraska Ethanol Board members during one of the yearly meetings stating what they have accomplished through their experience.
