

Field to Fuel Video Contest

The Nebraska Ethanol Board presents the 5th annual Field to Fuel video contest, which encourages Nebraska high school students to explore the importance and value of American ethanol.

With a focus on educating the public about renewable fuels, students are asked to research, film and edit a two-minute video for a chance to win a \$1,000 grand prize.

Official Contest Rules

Eligible videos must be received and/or postmarked no later than **Jan. 31, 2019**. The top three video entries, as selected by a panel of judges, will receive the following prizes:

- First place: \$1,000
- Second place: \$600
- Third place: \$400

In addition, the winning entries will be featured at the Ethanol 2019: Emerging Issues Forum in Omaha during mid-April and will be posted on the Nebraska Ethanol Board website: www.ethanol.nebraska.gov.

Eligibility

The contest is open to students currently attending a Nebraska high school (grades 9-12 in a public, private or home school setting). Immediate family members of contest sponsors are not eligible to compete.

Requirements

- Video submissions must not exceed two minutes in length.
- There is no limit to the number of participants in the video; however, only one prize will be given per video, not per person.
- Video submissions must be original works and not contain copyrighted material or any material that is proprietary to a third party, which includes music.
- All videos will become the sole property of the Nebraska Ethanol Board.

How to Enter

Complete the Field to Fuel entry form and submit it along with a DVD, flash drive or unlisted YouTube link containing your video. Only one video may be submitted per team.
